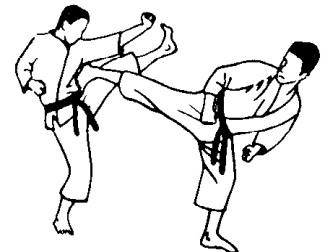

GREETINGS! Soke Robert Hill and I would like to personally invite you all to the 28th Annual All Butokukan Tournament on Saturday, March 31, 2007. This year once again we will have drawings for prizes for all competitors and judges. Also, this year we will add drawing for a tournament T-shirt for spectators. For competitors, each division entered gains one entry (maximum of three entries) and judges will gain one ticket for judging kata and one entry for judging kumite (maximum of two entries). This year we will once again have the black belt open in kata where all competitors will perform one of the Butokukan katas which will be chosen at random at the time of the event. We had more black belts turn out for this event than ever last year. Another returning favorite this year is the Black Belt Kata Grand Champion, where winners from Black Belt Traditional Kata, Black Belt Open Kata, and Black Belt Weapons Kata will compete against each other at the finals. Also, this year we will be skipping a dinner break before finals. This will allow us to finish the tournament earlier and we will have more time to get together at the East Bremerton Dojo. Awards: Heavy Gold, Silver, Bronze Medals to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places; Medallions to 4th and 5th places. Participation ribbons to all competitors.
Black Belt Grand Champion Trophy for Kata and Kumite.

Prizes: Prizes will be awarded for competitors, judges, tournament helpers, and spectators. Prizes to be determined prior to event.

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

FROM KINGSTON FERRY: Coming off the ferry you will be on Hwy 104 which after awhile will become Bond Rd. You will come to a stop light at the corner of Bond Rd. and Hwy 305. Turn right, then look for the sign for Hwy 3 (Bremerton/Silverdale). Get on Hwy 3 going southbound. Stay on Hwy 3 until exit for Hwy 303 (East Bremerton). Take that exit. Stay on Hwy 303, which will become Wheaton Way. Stay on Wheaton Way until you go through the intersection of Wheaton Way and Sylvan Way. The next intersection will be Wheaton Way and Sheridan, where you will get into the left turn lane and go left on Sheridan Rd. Then you will take a left on Spruce Rd. The American Legion is to your left and a ball field will be on the right. Follow the road into the Bremerton Jr. High parking lot.

FROM BREMERFON FERRY: Turn right onto Washington Ave. Stay on Washington (it becomes 11th Ave.) until you get to 11th and Warren Ave. Turn right onto Warren Ave. and stay in the right lane. Cross the bridge and at the traffic light you will turn right onto Sheridan Rd. Turn left onto Spruce Rd. The American Legion is to your left and a ball field will be on the right. Follow the road into the Bremerton Jr. High parking lot.

FROM TACOMA: Take Hwy 16 into Bremerton. You will pass the exits for Port Orchard. Stay in the right lanes (left lanes take you to Silverdale and Hood Canal Bridge). Follow curve along the waterfront where you will pass Puget Sound Naval Shipyard. Stay on that road. When you come to the intersection of Callow and Burwell, go straight on Callow. You will cross 6th St. Turn right at the next intersection which will be Callow and 11th. After you go through two stoplights, you will come down a hill. At the stoplight at the bottom of the hill, turn left onto Warren Ave. Cross the bridge and at the traffic light turn right onto Sheridan Rd. Turn left onto Spruce Rd. The American Legion is to your left and a ball field will be on the right. Follow the road into the Bremerton Jr. High parking lot.

AFTER THE TOURNAMENT FINALS

TO SILVERDALE DOJO: From Bremerton Junior High School, turn right onto Sheridan Rd. Then turn right again onto Wheaton Way. Follow Wheaton Way all the way through East Bremerton, past the Brownsville Rd. intersection. The road you're on is now called Waaga Way. Stay on this road until it becomes a freeway. Stay in the lane for the Bremerton/Hwy 3 South exit. The freeway ends with a light at the intersection. This is Clear Creek Rd. Turn right on Clear Creek Rd. and proceed about one mile to the Silverdale Dojo on the left. (Clear Creek Community Club, 12641 Clear Creek Road)
